**NOTES**

At six month follow-up, Sammi and her mother have been involved in trauma-focused treatment at our Child Advocacy Center now for the last two months. She has been progressing well in the individual therapy component, attending every other week.

I also learned that Ms. Hartwin was able to enroll her in the after school program at the new day care for Tony Jr. Sammi's therapist report indicates that Sammi has spoken favorably about this program many times and that the program and it's caring adults seem to be very valuable assets for Sammi at this time.

Ms. Hartwin expressed in this most recent follow-up that she would like to join a parenting group – I provided her the therapist's contact information, and expect that she will be joining the parental support group later this month, as it conveniently is held at a time Sammi will already be in the building.
