Authority/Responsibility

- You conduct forensic interviews at the Child Advocacy Center in your jurisdiction.
- You assist with coordinating the multidisciplinary team's investigation of child abuse and neglect.
- You convene and lead periodic Case Review meetings on CAC cases.

Character Tips

Module #3

- In this module, you will conduct a forensic interview of Sammi Hartwin (while the FA conducts an interview with the Non Offending Caregiver, Anna Hartwin).
 - You will have prepared documentation from your meeting (everyone will read either the longer "transcript-like" report, or the summary report).
- Following the forensic interview, the DT members will take turns sharing information relevant to their roles in the investigation. The team will work together to evaluate information that comes from the interview and will identify next steps.
 - Following this initial MDT meeting, the Family Advocate will invite the NOC into the post-interview meeting.
 - The FA will introduce Anna to all other MDT members, and you will speak first, and remind the NOC who you are, and the role you play in the investigation.
 - You share with the NOC a brief outline of the information the child shared during the forensic interview. You ask her if she has any questions, and then you may excuse yourself to go to complete the copying of the video to provide to key MDT members before they depart.
